Mondovi Community Youth Center finds new home at CCFBank

The Mondovi Community Youth Center (MCYC) is moving! The MCYC Board of Directors has worked for several months to finalize a formal partnership with CCFBank.

As a result, MCYC will be moving to a new, permanent location in the basement of the Mondovi bank branch. As part of the agreement, CCFBank has worked to renovate and improve the space for young people and families. MCYC will have access to an office, a kitchen, a large classroom space, two bathrooms, and an additional reading room in the basement of the bank, at no cost. CCFBank is contributing storage space, private access, and use of the green space in the adjacent lot.

MCYC Board of Directors President Donn Moe said, "This partnership is coming at just the right time and with just the right community partner. MCYC is excited to be in a new location at CCFBank that will solidify the sustainability of MCYC into the future."

MCYC Board of Directors Tracy Kluge, Candi Bollinger, and Josh Close worked together with CCFBank staff and Senior Vice President, Rebecca Reinhardt to carry out all the logistics. Reinhardt says of the CCFBank and MCYC partnership, "We are excited to support the youth development programming of MCYC and to help address childcare needs of families in Mondovi, and the surrounding area. We look forward to a strong, ongoing partnership between CCFBank and MCYC." The partnership was finalized on October 1st. Students will start going to the MCYC after school program at CCFBank on October 10th.
